

Isolation Requirements

NOTE: Requirements and recommendations for students and employees are based on isolation guidance provided by the <u>Centers for Disease Control</u> (CDC), <u>Oregon Health Authority</u> (OHA) and Local Public Health Authority (LPHA). LBCC students and employees must adhere to these guidelines unless

otherwise directed. Student and employee isolation requirements

If experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, you are required to:

- Isolate until symptoms are resolved (i.e., no fever for 24 hours without fever-reducing medications).
- Get tested.
- Follow all public health guidance.

If tested positive for COVID-19 and are symptomatic, you are required to:

- Isolate for at least **five days** after onset of symptoms and until all symptoms are resolved (i.e., no fever for 24 hours without fever-reducing medications).
- Wear a well-fitting mask around others for at least **10 days** from the onset of symptoms.

If tested positive for COVID-19 and are asymptomatic, you are required to:

- Isolate for **five days** from the date of the test.
- Wear a well-fitting mask around others for **10 days** from the positive test.

If exposed (close contact) to a confirmed or presumptive COVID-19 case, you are required to:

- Wear well-fitting masks around others for **10 days** from the date of exposure.
- Monitor for symptoms.
- Test on day five, if possible.
- Not required to isolate, unless you develop symptoms.
- Get retested if symptoms appear.

Exposure and symptoms definitions

- **Exposure** Being in close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes in a 24-hour period) with a person who has recently tested positive for COVID-19.
