

<u>Current LBCC/DPP Students -- Recently added DPP and either</u> <u>continuing at Linn-Benton or ready to transition to WOU:</u>

Congratulations on your admission to WOU!

Students who are in the Degree Partnership Program have ten terms of an active student status at WOU, even if they decide not to take classes at WOU during those ten terms. Many Linn-Benton students will continue taking their classes all at LBCC until they are ready to transition to WOU. DPP students who are not taking WOU courses are not automatically charged the per term student fees. Students need to be taking at least one credit (or elect to pay the per term student services fee) in order to have full access to WOU services and resources.

If you are ready to take classes at WOU for the first time, you will want to plan on attending a <u>new student orientation session</u> for transfer students at WOU called TSOAR*. At the orientation, you will meet with an WOU advisor who will recommend classes and clear you to register within WOU's system. Let your WOU advisor know you are dual enrolled-- there may still be classes you can pick up at LBCC.
