Student Quick Tips

> College Now students should -

- Complete the one time FREE High School Partnerships (College Now) application at <u>Apply Online for High School Partnerships Program</u> at the beginning of the school year.
- Retain your LBCC ID# X00----- you will use it to log into WebRunner
- Communicate with your College Now teacher that you are a College Now student; sign up on the teachers College Now Class roster.
- Withdraw/Drop Course: Work hard to earn an A, B, C grade in each course. If there
 is a question about passing a course, consider withdrawing/dropping prior to the
 deadline. The withdraw (W) credits will still count as attempted, but will not affect
 your GPA as would a D or F, but might effect your Financial Aid eligibility.

Discuss with your counselor/advisor:

- What classes will be beneficial College Now classes for your career/college plan.
- Financial Aid Implications: Students are limited to financial aid eligibility only for 150% of the published credit length of a selected academic program. All credits attempted, including college credits attempted in high school, count toward the 150% limit for your selected program (approximately 135 credits for a two year degree) For more information please see <u>Academic Standards for</u> Financial Aid
