## Call to Order & Welcome: Met Quorum

# **Hearing of Guests and Special Reports:**

- 1. Director of Facilities: Terrell Langley
  - a. John Berry--Maintenance Lead, introduced himself. Laura--Secretary, introduced herself. Terrell and staff want to provide safety measures and comfort to the student body. Want campus to feel like home. Custodial staff is here to serve us

and make us feel welcome. North of NSH, The Service Center. They need feedback and think partnering with SLC will help keep the campus looking clean and inviting.

# 2. Andrew Rogers

- a. Andrew is the OSA Communications Director statewide. Gave a brief overview of campaign and gave a heads up on signing up and getting engaged with important work. Advice for class raps: Reach out to professors ahead of time to schedule class raps. Get your faces out there. Get a registration card in everyone's hand. Some will realize they need to vote. It helps get a count of people. November 6th election: Tuesday, October 16 is the deadline. Be non-partisan. Tell them why and walk them through the registration card. Must be complete, it's an official document.
- b. Make a volunteer pitch. Encourage them to get involved.
- c. Walk them through optional demographics. Collect all the cards back. Thank the professor.
- d. What do they do if they don't have an address? Confirm with county elections office. It depends on the county.
- e. Ways to get involved: class raps, phone banking, card processing, tabling, and clipboarding.

    - i. Must show that there is a benefit of funding a trip or activity
    - ii. If asking for \$200 or more it will be a discuscussion item at the first meeting, then approved as an action item for the next meeting. Must prove it has benefit.
    - iii. Minimum of two weeks, max of a month. Important to plan ahead with expenses.
    - iv. Raise quorum from 4+chair to 5+chair.
  - b. Jacob moves to approve bylaws; Brent seconds. Passes 9-0-1

- a. Caleb moves to move Harvest Festival to action items; Waldo seconds. **Passes** 9-0-1

      Festival/Halloween activities, so that won't conflict. SLC can
      promote the DAC and send people up there during Harvest
      Festival.
