- 1. Return a completed admissions application to the Admissions Office, 6500 Pacific Blvd. SW, Albany, OR 97321 or apply online at www.linnbenton.edu
- 2. If transferring credits from another college or university, have an official transcript sent to LBCC Admissions.
- 3. Make an appointment to take the required placement examination through our Student Assessment Center website at www.linnbenton.edu/cpt
- 4. Attend a New Student Center Orientation. Please be advised the NSC appointment could take up to 4 hours. Students are welcome to take placement testing prior to attending the NSC appointment. If you choose to test beforehand, plan to be at your NSC appointment at least an hour.
